



PROGRAM SUBSIDY PROGRAM
Sturgeon County Subsidy and Sponsor a Child Program

Sturgeon County Community Services administers programs that will subsidize, when possible, program fees for children and adults who demonstrate an inability to pay for programs that are offered through the Municipalities within Sturgeon and Edmonton Garrison. Subsidies for summer programs are available for families within any of the communities and rural area within Sturgeon County. Subsidies for programs from September to June are available for Sturgeon County ratepayers.

To qualify for program the combined **net** family income should be less than listed below **or** have extraordinary living expenses that would impact ability to pay:

\$22,397.00 for a family of 1 child
\$26,628.00 for a family of 2 children
\$33,221.00 for a family of 3 children
\$37,828.00 for a family of 4 children
\$41,953.00 for a family of 5 children
\$46,077.00 for a family of 6 children

- Program subsidy may be provided for a maximum of \$175.00 per person per year to a maximum of \$400.00 per family per year.
- Applicants will be encouraged to pay an affordable portion of the program fee.
- Applicant must not have received subsidy for the program from any other source.
- Applicant must complete the request for subsidy application form.
- If applicant does not attend the registered course or program, future applications for assistance may be affected.
- The decision of the Community Services Department is final.
